NOTICE OF ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the annual general meeting of Huajin International Holdings Limited (the “**Company**”) will be held at The Chairman’s Place, New World Millennium Hong Kong Hotel, 72 Mody Road, Tsim Sha Tsui East, Kowloon, Hong Kong on Thursday, 28 June 2018 at 2:30 p.m. to consider and, if thought fit, transact the following ordinary businesses:

1. To consider and adopt the audited consolidated financial statements, the reports of the directors (the “**Directors**”) and the independent auditor of the Company for the year ended 31 December 2017.
2. (a) To declare and pay a final dividend of HK2.0 cents per ordinary share of the Company out of the share premium account of the Company (the “**Final Dividend**”) for the year ended 31 December 2017 to the shareholders of the Company whose names appear on the register of members of the Company on the record date fixed by the board of Directors (the “**Board**”) for determining the entitlements to the Final Dividend; and
(b) To authorize any Director of the Company to take such action, do such things and execute such further documents as the Director may at his absolute discretion consider necessary or desirable for the purpose of or in connection with the implementation of the payment of the Final Dividend.
3. (a) To re-elect Mr. Xu Songqing as an executive Director of the Company;
(b) To re-elect Mr. Xu Jianhong as a non-executive Director of the Company;
(c) To re-elect Mr. Goh Choo Hwee as an independent non-executive Director of the Company;
(d) To re-elect Mr. Tam Yuk Sang Sammy as an independent non-executive Director of the Company; and

- (e) To authorise the Board to fix the remuneration of the Directors.
4. To re-appoint Deloitte Touche Tohmatsu as the Company's auditor and authorize the Board to fix the remuneration of the auditor.

As special business, to consider and, if thought fit, pass with or without amendments, the following resolutions as ordinary resolutions:

5. **“THAT:**

- (a) subject to paragraph (c) below, pursuant to the Rules Governing the Listing of Securities (the **“Listing Rules”**) on The Stock Exchange of Hong Kong Limited (the **“Stock Exchange”**), the exercise by the directors of the Company during the Relevant Period (as hereinafter defined) of all the powers of the Company to allot, issue and deal with additional shares in the share of the Company (the **“Shares”**) and securities convertible into such Shares or warrants or similar rights to subscribe for any Shares and to make or grant offers, agreements and options (including but not limited to bonds, warrants, debentures, notes convertible into Shares) which would or might require the exercise of such powers be and is hereby generally and unconditionally approved;
- (b) the approval in paragraph (a) of this resolution shall be in addition to any other authorisation given to the Directors and shall authorise the Directors during the Relevant Period to make or grant offers, agreements and options (including but not limited to bonds, warrants, debentures, notes convertible into Shares) which would or might require the exercise of such powers after the end of the Relevant Period;
- (c) the aggregate number of Shares allotted and issued or agreed conditionally or unconditionally to be allotted (whether pursuant to an option or otherwise) and issued by the Directors pursuant to the approval in paragraph (a) of this resolution, otherwise than pursuant to (i) a Rights Issue (as defined below); or (ii) the exercise of options granted under any share option scheme or similar arrangement adopted from time to time by the Company; or (iii) any scrip dividend or similar arrangements providing for the allotment and issue of Shares in lieu of the whole or part of a dividend on Shares in accordance with the articles of association (the **“Articles of Association”**) of the Company in force from time to time; or (iv) any issue of Shares upon the exercise of rights of subscription or conversion under the terms of any warrants of the Company or any securities which are convertible into Shares shall not exceed the aggregate of:
 - (i) 20 percent of the number of issued Shares on the date of the passing of this resolution; and
 - (ii) (if the Directors are so authorised by a separate ordinary resolution of the shareholders of the Company) the aggregate number of Shares purchased by the Company subsequent to the passing of this resolution (up to a maximum equivalent to 10 percent of the number of issued Shares on the date of the passing of this resolution),

and the authority pursuant to paragraph (a) of this resolution shall be limited accordingly.

- (d) for the purpose of this resolution, “**Relevant Period**” means the period from the date of the passing of this resolution until whichever is the earliest of:
- (i) the conclusion of the next annual general meeting of the Company;
 - (ii) the expiration of the period within which the next annual general meeting of the Company is required by the Articles of Association or any applicable law of the Cayman Islands to be held; or
 - (iii) the revocation or variation of the authority given to the Directors under this resolution by an ordinary resolution passed by the shareholders of the Company in general meeting.

“**Rights Issue**” means an offer of Shares or offer or issue of options, warrants or other securities giving the rights to subscribe for Shares open for a period fixed by the Board to holders of Shares whose names appear on the Company’s register of members on a fixed record date in proportion to their then holdings of such Shares (subject to such exclusions or other arrangements as the Directors may deem necessary or expedient in relation to fractional entitlements or having regard to any restrictions or obligations under the laws of, or the requirements of, any recognised regulatory body or any stock exchange in, or in any territory outside Hong Kong, or the expense or delay that may be incurred in the determination of any such restrictions or obligations).”

6. “**THAT:**

- (a) subject to paragraph (b) below, the exercise by the Directors during the Relevant Period (as hereinafter defined) of all the powers of the Company to purchase Shares on the Stock Exchange, or any other stock exchange on which the securities of the Company may be listed and recognised by the Securities and Future Commission of Hong Kong (“**SFC**”) and the Stock Exchange for this purpose, and otherwise in accordance with the rules and regulations of the SFC, the Stock Exchange, the Companies Law and all other applicable laws in this regard, be and the same is hereby generally and unconditionally approved;
- (b) the aggregate number of Shares which may be purchased by the Company pursuant to the authority granted pursuant to paragraph (a) above during the Relevant Period (as hereinafter defined) shall not exceed 10% of the aggregate number of Shares in issue as at the date of the passing of this resolution, provided that if any subsequent consolidation or subdivision of Shares is effected, the maximum number of Shares that may be purchased by the Company pursuant to the authority granted pursuant to paragraph (a) above as a percentage of the total number of issued Shares immediately before and after such consolidation or subdivision shall be the same and such maximum number of Shares adjusted accordingly; and

- (c) for the purpose of this resolution, “**Relevant Period**” means the period from the date of the passing of this resolution until whichever is the earliest of:
- (i) the conclusion of the next annual general meeting of the Company;
 - (ii) the expiration of the period within which the next annual general meeting of the Company is required by the Articles of Association or any applicable law of the Cayman Islands to be held; or
 - (iii) the revocation or variation of the authority given to the Directors under this resolution by an ordinary resolution passed by the shareholders of the Company in general meetings.
7. “**THAT** conditional on the passing of resolutions set out in the notice convening this meeting as resolutions numbered 5 and 6, the general mandate granted to the Directors of the Company pursuant to the approval granted under the resolution set out in the notice convening this meeting as resolution numbered 5 above be and is hereby extended by the addition to the aggregate nominal amount of the share capital of the Company which may be allotted or agreed conditionally or unconditionally to be allotted by the Directors of the Company pursuant to or in accordance with such general mandate an amount representing the aggregate nominal amount of the share capital of the Company which has been repurchased by the Company since the granting of such general mandate pursuant to the exercise by the Directors of the Company of the powers of the Company to repurchase such Shares pursuant to or in accordance with the authority granted under the resolution set out in the notice convening this meeting as resolution numbered 6, provided that such amount shall not exceed 10% of the aggregate nominal amount of the issued share capital of the Company as at the date of passing this resolution.”

In the case of joint holders of a Share, any one of such joint holders may vote, either in person or by proxy, in respect of such Share as if he/she were solely entitled thereto in the meeting, but if more than one of such joint holders be present at any meeting the vote of the senior who tenders a vote, whether in person or by proxy, shall be accepted to the exclusion of the votes of the other joint holders, and for this purpose seniority shall be determined by the order in which the names stand in the register of members of the Company in respect of the joint holding.

The register of members of the Company will be closed from Monday, 25 June 2018 to Thursday, 28 June 2018 (both days inclusive), during which period no transfer of shares in the Company will be effected. In order to qualify for attending the annual general meeting, all transfers of Shares, accompanied by the relevant share certificates, must be lodged with the Company's branch share registrar and transfer office in Hong Kong, Union Registrars Limited, at Suites 3301-04, 33/F., Two Chinachem Exchange Square, 338 King's Road, North Point, Hong Kong, not later than 4:00 p.m. on Friday, 22 June 2018 for registration.
5. In relation to proposed resolution numbered 2 above, the proposed final dividend will be payable to the shareholders whose names appear on the register of members of the Company on Tuesday, 31 July 2018 and the register of members of the Company will be closed from Thursday, 26 July 2018 to Tuesday, 31 July 2018 (both days inclusive). In order to qualify for the proposed final dividend, all transfers of Shares, accompanied by the relevant share certificates, must be lodged with the Company's branch share registrar and transfer office in Hong Kong, Union Registrars Limited, at Suites 3301-04, 33/F., Two Chinachem Exchange Square, 338 King's Road, North Point, Hong Kong, not later than 4:00 p.m. on Wednesday, 25 July 2018 for registration.
6. In relation to proposed resolutions numbered 5 and 7 above, approval is being sought from the shareholders for the grant to the directors of a general mandate to authorise the allotment and issue of shares under the Listing Rules.
7. In relation to proposed resolution numbered 6 above, the directors of the Company wish to state that they will exercise the powers conferred thereby to purchase Shares in circumstances which they deem appropriate for the benefit of the shareholders. An explanatory statement containing the information necessary to enable the shareholders to make an informed decision to vote on the proposed resolution as required by the Listing Rules is set out in the Appendix I to the circular of the Company dated 19 April 2018.
8. Delivery of an instrument appointing a proxy shall not preclude a shareholder from attending and voting in person at the above meeting convened and in such event, the instrument appointing a proxy shall be deemed to be revoked.
9. In the event that a black rainstorm warning signal or a tropical cyclone warning signal number 8 or above is hoisted or remains hoisted at any time after 11:30 a.m. on the date of the annual general meeting, the annual general meeting will be adjourned until further notice.

Further announcement notifying Shareholders of details (including the date, time and venue) of the adjourned meeting will be posted on the websites of the Stock Exchange and the Company.

If a black rainstorm warning signal or tropical cyclone warning signal number 8 or above is cancelled at or before 11:30 a.m. on the date of the annual general meeting, and where conditions permit, the annual general meeting will be held as scheduled.
